TEGERA 883, 884 palm dipped gloves, made of polyamide/elastane, with or without dots in black colour with biological active finish accepted by OEKO-TEX® Association.
TEGERA 873, 874, 875 palm dipped gloves, grey or white made of polyamide/spandex with nitril coating.
TEGERA 907, cut resistance glove with HPPE (high performance polyethylene), green with black nitrile dots.
TEGERA 8807, 8808, 8811, 8812 15G grey knitted nylon and HPPE glove with NBR coating.
TEGERA 8800, 8801 15G and 8802, 8803, 8804 18G black and yellow knitted nylon glove with NBR coating.
TEGERA 8805, 8806 grey and yellow 18G knitted cut resistant glove made from nylon, HPPE, stainless steel yarn, carbon thread with NBR coating.
TEGERA 8810 black and yellow winter glove with acrylic lining, outer layer in nylon and dipped in NBR.
TEGERA 8814 grey and black cut resistant glove made out of polyester, HPPE, stainless steel yarn, basalt fibre and dipped in NBR.
TEGERA 456 white knitted nylon HPPE glove with NBR coating.
Including accessories: sewing thread, heat transfer print, rubber ring and labels.


